SEND GREETING

Whereas, we the said Kenneth E. Shaw and Judy J. Shaw

in and by our certain promissory

note in writing, of even date with

these presents, are well and truly indebted to W. L. Woodson

in the full and just sum of One Thousand Nine Hundred Sixteen and 76/100 (\$1,916.76)

Dollars to be paid in monthly installments of Twenty and No/100 Dollars (\$20.00) each, the first such payment beginning on the first day of July, 1966 and the last payment being due on the first day of June, 1977, with the privilege of pre-payment without penalty

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 6 1/2 per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing

for an attorney's fee of a reasonable amount besides all costs and expense of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money

aforsaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said W. L. Woodson

according to the terms of said note, and also in

consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us the said Kenneth E. Shaw and

Judy J. Shaw in hand well and truly paid by the said W. L. Woodson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. L. Woodson, his heirs and assigns forever; the following described property, to wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Oaklawn Township, about fifteen miles South of Greenville on Holland Ford Road between Ware Place and Cooley Bridge Road, being Lot 2 on plat by B. M. Smith, Surveyor, December 10, 1958, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book 00 at page 179 and described as follows: BEGINNING at a point in center of said road, same as State Highway No. 52, South, joint front corner of Tracts 1 and 2, thence North 72-18 West 610.9 feet to iron pin on line of property now or formerly of Mrs. Wilson, joint rear corner of Tracts 1 and 2, thence North 48-05 East 240 feet to iron pin, joint corner of Tracts 2 and 3, thence South 66-35 East 479.7 feet to point in center of said road, joint front corner of Tracts 2 and 3, thence South 20-35 West 150 feet to the beginning.
