MORTGAGE LIEN

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, Liberty Life Insurance Company does hereby release and forever discharge the below described real estate from the lien of that certain mortgage given to it by Real Estate Fund, Inc., dated May 24, 1965, in the original amount of Ninety-Two Thousand and No/100 (\$92,000.00) Dollars and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Mortgage Book 995, page 397:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being on the northwesterly side of Pleasantburg Drive, in McAlister Plaza, in the City of Greenville, S. C., County and State aforesaid, being designated as a portion of a lot, entitled, "Real Estate Fund, Inc.", as shown on a plat made by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, dated January 2, 1964 entitled "Portion of McAlister Plaza" and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book RR, page 159 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwesterly edge of the right-of-way for Pleasantburg Drive, corner of property designated on said plat as American Security Investment Company but now owned by Schoolfield, said pin being located 442.5 feet southwest of the southwesterly corner of the intersection of Pleasantburg Drive and West Antrim Drive and running thence along the northwesterly edge of the right-of-way of Pleasantburg Drive S 26-11 W 100 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running N 63-49 W 228 feet to an iron pin, corner of Property of J. E. Serrine Company; thence turning and running with the line of Serrine Property N 26-11 E 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of the Schoolfield lot; thence turning and running with the line of the Schoolfield property S 63-49 E 228 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to Real Estate Fund, Inc. by the deed recorded in said RMC Office in Deed Book 746, page 3.
