Willis E. Case (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Two Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$2,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six and one-half (6 1/2 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, except that the final

payment of principal and interest shall be due on April 1, 1977, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and furthersums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fairview Township, in the Town of Fountain Inn, known and designated as Lots Nos. 26 and 27, in the Subdivision known as Woodland Heights, as shown on a plat prepared by Lewis C. Godsey, Surveyor, in May 1954, said Plat of record is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE, at page 101. Said lots front on Woodland Drive a total of 150 feet, running back a depth of 168.6 feet along the joint line of Lot No. 25 to a branch, being 131.50 feet wide in the rear along branch and being 165.5 feet deep along the joint line of Lot No. 28 and bounded by said Woodland Drive, Lots Nos. 25 and 28, and a branch.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Audrey B. Marljar, to be recorded of even date herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
