

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of lot now or formerly owned by Marshall Thompson (shown on the Block Book as J. L. Bowen) and being the second lot above described and running thence N. 72 W. 88-1/2 feet to an iron pin in the line of lot now or formerly of P. F. Cox (shown on Block Book as Edward W. Pike); thence in a southerly direction, 5-1/2 feet to an iron pin; thence with Cox line, N. 72 W. about 108 feet to the corner of lot now or formerly belonging to Alexander (shown on Block Book as J. N. Wrenn); thence with Alexander's line in a southerly direction 30.0 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot now or formerly belonging to J. I. Wilson; thence along Wilson's line, S. 62 E. 188 feet to an iron pin on Green Avenue; thence with Green Avenue in a northerly direction, 65-1/2 feet, to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by John L. Ashmore by deed dated January 29, 1965 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 766 at Page 573."
