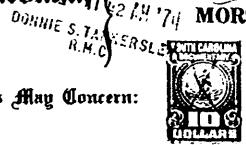

Bonner, in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to FIRST PIEDMONT FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GAFFNEY, S.
