All that certain piece, panel or lot of find with all improvements element or hereafter to be constructed through, situate, bong and being in the State of South Carlina, County of Greenville, on the northern side of Tenth Street, Section 5 of Judson Mills Village and being known and designated as Lot 38 on a plat of Section 5 of Judson Mills Village made by Dalton & Neves in February 1940 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book K at Pages 33 and 34, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
