MODIFICATION AND EXTENSION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made the 16th day of September, 1974,
between The Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina,
and/or its successors and assigns, a national bank organized
under the laws of the United States of America, hereinafter called
"Bank," and Argo Construction Co., Inc., hereinafter called the
"Obligor,"

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Bank is the owner and holder of a note dated July 6, 1973, executed by the Obligor in the original amount of Fifty-Three Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$53,000.00) and secured by a mortgage on the property of the Obligor known and designated as:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northwestern side of Patrol Club Road near the foot of Paris Mountain, which contains 6.8 acres, more or less, and which is described more particularly according to a plat of the property of Morris E. Nichols and Dorothy B. Nichols prepared by Jones Engineering Service, dated May, 1966, to be recorded herewith as follows:

BEGINNING at a point which is the Northeastern most corner of the property conveyed hereby and running thence S 5-48 W 503 feet to a point; thence S 5-52 W 201 feet; thence N 30-03 W 43.3 feet; thence N 69-28 W 118.17 feet; thence N 84-50 W 99.8 feet; thence N 89-31 W 175.3 feet; thence N 32-04 W 330.1 feet; and thence N 73-45 E 848.3 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

ALSO, all that piece, parcel or tract of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township. This being a part of property deeded to C. M. Black by Mae Wynn Black, dated August 14, 1967, recorded in Book of Deeds 582, Page 279.
