

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the said building or in any way incident or appertaining, including all built-in stoves and refrigerators, shall be held by the Mortgagor. The same will be subject to wall carpeting, fences and gates, and any other equipment or fixtures, which may be attached to the building, all as per the intent of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment shall remain in the possession of the Mortgagor in respect of the realty.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor represents and warrants that said Mortgagor is owner of the above described premises unto the date hereof, that the above described premises are free and clear of all liens or other encumbrances, that the Mortgagor is lawfully empowered to convey or transfer the same, and that the Mortgagor will forever defend the said premises unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns from and against the Mortgagor and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same or any part thereof.

THE MORTGAGOR COVENANTS AND AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Mortgagor will promptly pay the principal and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by said promissory note at the times and in the manner therein provided.
2. That this mortgage will secure the Mortgagor for any additional sums which may be advanced thereafter, at the option of the Mortgagor, for the payment of taxes, or public assessments, hazard insurance, plus taxes, or other similar expenses paid to the provisions of this mortgage, and also for any loans or advances that may hereafter be made by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor under the authority of Sec. 45-55, 1962 Code of laws of South Carolina, as amended, or similar statutes, and all sums so advanced I shall bear the interest at the same rate or rates as that provided in said note unless otherwise agreed upon by the parties and shall be payable at the demand of the Mortgagee, unless otherwise provided in writing.
3. That Mortgagor will keep the improvements on the mortgaged premises, whether now existing or hereafter erected, insured against loss by fire, windstorm and other hazards in a sum not less than the balance due hereunder at any time, and in a company or companies acceptable to the Mortgagee, and Mortgagor does hereby assign the policy or policies of insurance to the Mortgagee and agrees that all such policies shall be held by the Mortgagee should it so require, and shall include loss payable clauses in favor of the Mortgagee, and in the event of loss, Mortgagor will give prompt notice thereof to the Mortgagee, his successors, and assigns, and if the Mortgagor at any time fail to keep said premises insured or fail to pay the premium for such insurance, then the Mortgagee may cause such improvements to be insured in the name of the Mortgagee and demands shall be for the cost of such insurance, with interest as hereinabove provided.
4. That the Mortgagor will keep all improvements upon the mortgaged premises in good repair, and should Mortgagor fail to do so the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises and make whatever repairs are necessary, and charge the expenses for such repairs to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
5. That the Mortgagee may at any time require the payment and maintenance of insurance upon the land or any personal chattel or under the indebtedness secured hereby in a sum sufficient to pay the mortgage debt, with the Mortgagee as beneficiary, and if the premiums are not otherwise paid, the Mortgagee may pay said premiums and any amount so paid shall become a part of the mortgage debt.
6. That Mortgagor agrees to pay all taxes and other public assessments levied against the mortgaged premises on or before the due dates thereof, and to exhibit the records therefor at the offices of the Mortgagee immediately upon payment, and should the Mortgagor fail to pay such taxes and assessments when the same shall fall due, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay the same and charge the amounts so paid to the mortgage debt and collect the same under this mortgage, with interest as hereinabove provided.
7. That if this mortgage secures a "Construction Loan", the Mortgagor agrees that the principal amount of the indebtedness hereby secured shall be disbursed to the Mortgagor in periodic payments, as construction progresses, in accordance with the terms and conditions of a Construction Loan Agreement which is separately executed but is made a part of this mortgage and incorporated herein by reference.
8. That the Mortgagor will not further encumber the premises, or any portion thereof, without the prior consent of the Mortgagee, and should the Mortgagor so encumber said premises the Mortgagee may, at its option, declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable, and may institute any proceeding to recover the debt and indebtedness.
9. That should the Mortgagor release the mortgaged premises by Contract of Sale, Deed for Lien, or Deed of Covenants, and the within mortgage indebtedness is not paid in full, the Mortgagor or his Purchaser shall be required to file with the Association an application for an assumption of the mortgage indebtedness, pay the reasonable costs as required by the Association for processing the assumption, furnish the Association with a copy of the Contract of Sale, Deed for Lien, or Deed of Covenants, and have the interest rate on the loan balance existing at the time of transfer modified by increasing the interest rate on the said loan balance to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase in interest rate as may be determined by the Association. The Association will notify the Mortgagor of the new interest rate and monthly payments, and will send him a new payoff. Should the Mortgagor, or his Purchaser fail to comply with the provisions of the within paragraph, the Mortgagee, at its option, may declare the indebtedness hereby secured to be immediately due and payable and may institute any proceedings necessary to collect said indebtedness.
10. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and the same shall be unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days or if there should be any failure to comply with and abide by any law or the rules of the Master of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the Mortgagee, at its option, may write to the Mortgagor at his last known address giving him thirty (30) days in which to rectify the said default and should the Mortgagor fail to rectify said default within the said thirty days the Mortgagee may, at its option, increase the interest rate on the original loan, to the remaining term of the loan, or for a lesser term to the maximum rate per annum permitted to be charged at that time by applicable South Carolina law, or a lesser increase rate as may be determined by the Association. The monthly payments will be adjusted accordingly.
11. That should the Mortgagor fail to make payments of principal and interest as due on the promissory note and should any monthly installment become past due for a period in excess of 15 days, the Mortgagee may collect a "late charge" not to exceed an amount equal to five (5%) per centum of any such past due installment or for to cover the extra expense incurred to the handling of such delinquent payments.
12. That the Mortgagor hereby assigns to the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, all the rents, issues, and profits accruing from the mortgaged premises, retaining the right to collect the same so long as the said hereby secured is not in arrears of payment, but should any part of the principal indebtedness, or interest, taxes, or fee, insurance premiums, be past due and unpaid, the Mortgagee may without notice or further proceedings take over the mortgaged premises, if they shall be occupied by a tenant or tenants, and collect said rents and profits and apply the same to the indebtedness hereby secured, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected, less the cost of collection, and any tenant is authorized again to rent to Mortgagee, to make all rental payments direct to the Mortgagee, without liability to the Mortgagor, until settled to the contrary by the Mortgagee, and should said premises at the time of such default be occupied by the Mortgagor, the Mortgagee may apply to the Judge of the County Court or to any Judge of the Court of Common Pleas who shall be selected according to the county aforesaid for the appointment of a receiver with authority to take possession of said premises and collect rents and profits applying said rents, after paying the cost of collection, to the mortgage debt, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually collected.
13. That the Mortgagor, at its option, may require the Mortgagor to pay to the Mortgagee, on the first day of each month until the note secured hereby is fully paid, the following sum in addition to the payments of principal and interest provided in said note, a sum equal to the premiums that will next become due and payable on policies of insurance mentioned in Article VI, fire and other hazard insurance covering the mortgaged property, plus taxes, and assessments next due on the mortgaged premises, all as estimated by the Mortgagee less all sums already paid thereon, divided by the number of months to elapse before one month prior to the date when such premiums, taxes, and assessments will be due and payable, such sum to be held by Mortgagee to pay said premiums, taxes, and special assessments. Should these payments exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes, assessments or insurance premiums, the excess may be credited to the Mortgagee on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, if, however, said sum shall be insufficient to make said payments when the same shall become due and payable, the Mortgagor shall pay to the Mortgagee any amounts necessary to make up the deficiency. The Mortgagor further agrees that at the end of ten years from the date hereof, Mortgagee may, at its option, apply for renewal of mortgage insurance or similar insurance, if applicable, covering the balance then remaining due on the mortgage debt, and the Mortgagor may, at its option, pay the whole premium required for the remaining years of the term, or the Mortgagee may pay such premium and add the same to the mortgage debt, in which event the Mortgagor shall repay to Mortgagee such premium payment, with interest, at the rate specified in said promissory note, in equal monthly installments over the remaining payment period.
