MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

LOUIE E. BROCK AND ELAINE P. BROCK

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) (SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) in the full and just sum of NINETEEN

THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND NO/100----- (\$ 19,800.00 )

Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, which note does not contain a provision for escalation of interest rate (paragraphs 9 and 10 of this mortgage provides for an escalation of interest rate under certain conditions), said note to be repaid with interest at the rate or rates therein specified in installments of ONE HUNDRED

FIFTY-FIVE AND 78/100----- (\$ 155.78 ) Dollars each on the first day of each month hereafter, in advance, until the principal sum with interest has been paid in full, such payments to be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on unpaid principal balances, and then to the payment of principal with the last payment, if not sooner paid, to be due and payable 30 years after date, and

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagor, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collateral given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagor for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW KNOW ALL MEN That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced to the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor is bound well and truly paid to the Mortgagor at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land with all improvements thereon or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, and the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the East side of Agewood Drive in the Town of Simpsonville, Austin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 502, Section V, Sheet One on plat of Westwood Subdivision, made by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, November 28, 1972, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book 4X at Page 62, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of Agewood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 501 and 502 and running thence along Agewood Drive N. 4-39 E. 86.0 feet to an iron pin; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 502 and 503 N. 85-21 W. 140.0 feet to an iron pin; thence running S. 4-39 W. 86.0 feet to an iron pin; thence running along the common line of Lots Nos. 501 and 502 S. 85-21 E. 140.0 feet to the point of beginning.
