NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagore, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby arbnowledged, has granted, burgained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, burgain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, being and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Town of Mauldin, being known and designated as Lot No. 52 of a subdivision known as Cedar Terrace as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book BBB, at Page 137, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
