together with all rights, interests, casements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, the rents, issues, and predits thereof and revenues and mecunic thereform, all improvements and personal property now or later attached therefore reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to, ranges, refrigerators, clothes washers, clothes drivers, or carpeting purchased or financed in while or in part with hour funds, all winer, water rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all payments at any time owing to Becrower by wirther of any sule, hence, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein all of which are herein called "the property"; IO HAMI AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever in fee simple.

MORROWER for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, nuccessors and assigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all traful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyances specified begreinablese, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

- (1) Ter pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is hold by an insured holder, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.
- (2) To pay to the Generament such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home Administration
- (3) If required by the Government, to make additional monthly payments of 1/12 of the estimated annual taxes, assessments, insurance prevalues and other charges upon the stortgaged prevalues.
- (4) Thether or not the note is insured by the Government, the Government may at any time pay any other amounts required herein to be paid by Borrower and not paid by him when due, as well as any costs and expenses for the preservation, protection, or enforcement of this lies, as advances for the account of Borrower. All such advances shall bear interest at the rate borne by the note which has the highest interest rate.
- (5) All advances by the Government as described in this instrument, with interest, shall be immediately due and payable by Burrower to the Government without demand at the place designated in the latest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advances by the Government shall relieve Burrower from breach id his covenant to pay. Any payment made by Burrower may be applied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any order the Government determines.
