## **MORTGAGE**

THIS MORTGAGE is made this 7th day of February 19 75 between the Mortgagor, George E. Little and Erna D. Little

and the Mortgagee, The South Carolina National Bank organized and existing under the laws of United States of America is Columbia, South Carolina

(herein "Borrower"), , a corporation , whose address (herein "Lender").

Whereas, Borrower is indebted to Lender in the principal sum of Forty Thousand and No/100------ Dollars, which indebtedness is evidenced by Borrower's note of even date herewith (herein "Note"), providing for monthly installments of principal and interest, with the balance of the indebtedness, if not sooner paid, due and payable on February 1, 2000

To Secure to Lender (a) the repayment of the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, with interest thereon, the payment of all other sums, with interest thereon, advanced in accordance herewith to protect the security of this Mortgage, and the performance of the covenants and agreements of Borrower herein contained, and (b) the repayment of any future advances, with interest thereon, made to Borrower by Lender pursuant to paragraph 21 hereof (herein "Future Advances"), Borrower does hereby mortgage, grant and convey to Lender and Lender's successors and assigns the following described property located in the County of Greenville , State of South Carolina:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 141 on a subdivision known as Pebble Creek, Phase I, as shown on plat thereof prepared by Enwright Associates, Engineers, dated October, 1973, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5-D, pages 1 through 5, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Hoppin John Lane, Joint front corner of Lots 140 and 141, and running thence along the southeastern side of Hoppin John Lane, N. 43-39 E. 110.0 feet to an iron pin at a front corner of Lot 142; thence along the line of that lot, S. 44-58 E. 220.15 feet to an iron pin on the line of property now or formerly of Norman L. Forrester; thence along the line of that property, S. 55-56 W. 120.6 feet to an iron pin at a rear corner of Lot 140; thence along the line of that lot, N. 42-29 W. 194.90 feet to the beginning corner.









To Have and to Hold unto Lender and Lender's successors and assigns, forever, together with all the improvements now or hereafter erected on the property, and all easements, rights, appurtenances, rents, royalties, mineral, oil and gas rights and profits, water, water rights, and water stock, and all fixtures now or hereafter attached to the property, all of which, including replacements and additions thereto, shall be deemed to be and remain a part of the property covered by this Mortgage; and all of the foregoing, together with said property (or the leasehold estate in the event this Mortgage is on a leasehold) are herein referred to as the "Property".

Borrower covenants that Borrower is lawfully seised of the estate hereby conveyed and has the right to mortgage, grant and convey the Property, that the Property is unencumbered, and that Borrower will warrant and defend generally the title to the Property against all claims and demands, subject to any easements and restrictions listed in a schedule of exceptions to coverage in any title insurance policy insuring Lender's interest in the Property.

UNIFORM COVENANTS. Borrower and Lender covenant and agree as follows:

1. Payment of Principal and Interest. Borrower shall promptly pay when due the principal of and interest on the indebtedness evidenced by the Note, prepayment and late charges as provided in the Note, and the principal of and interest on any Future Advances secured by this Mortgage.
