## MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

## TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS. Jeff R. Richardson, Jr. and Joseph A. McCullough, Jr.

thereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto J. Robert Thomason in accordance with Judgment Roll M-779 filed with the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-Five and 00/100------

in five (5) equal annual installments of One Thousand Five Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$1,511.00), plus interest, the first payment being due one year from date,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7-1/2 per centum per annum, to be paid: Annually

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3,00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, located, lying and being in the City of Fountain Inn, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the easterly side of Fairview Street, and having, according to a plat entitled "Property of J. R. Thomason Estate", made by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., dated March, 1974, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of Fairview Street, at the joint corner of property now or formerly of Eddie S. Smith, and running thence along the center of said street, S. 20-20 W. 100 feet to a nail and cap; thence S. 5-58 W. 290.4 feet to a nail and cap; thence S. 14-23 W. 100 feet to a nail and cap; thence S. 25-23 W. 149.1 feet to an old iron pin in the center of said street; thence leaving said street and running along the center line of property now or formerly of Land Fund Ltd., S. 66-14 E. 591.85 feet to an old iron pin and stone; thence N. 6-03 E. 483.5 feet to an old iron pin and stone; thence N. 88-18 W. 224.9 feet to an old iron pin and stone at the corner of property now or formerly of Fountain Inn Builders, Inc.; thence along the line of property of Fountain Inn Builders, Inc., N. 24-23 W. 161.5 feet to a stone; thence N. 44-54 W. 58.3 feet to a stone, the corner of property now or formerly of Eddie S. Smith; thence, N. 31-03 W. 205.9 feet to a nail and cap in the center of Fairview Street, the point and place of beginning.

The within mortgage is a purchase money mortgage.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting firtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its beirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

<sup>(1)</sup> That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall alresecure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, regivances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing

<sup>(2)</sup> That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.
