That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor's the Mortgagor's recount, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (53.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby a knowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor its successors and assigns, the following described real estate.

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Town of Fountain Inn, on the west side of Church Street with the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point at the southwest corner of the intersection of Church Street and Sixth Streets and running thence along the west side of Church Street, S. 37-33 E. 82 feet; thence S. 52-55 W. 139 feet; thence N. 40-1/4 W. 82 feet to a point on the south side of Sixth Street; thence along the south side of Sixth Street, N. 52-55 E. 139 feet to the beginning corner;

Church Street is now known as Woodside Avenue and Sixth Street is known as Shaw Street.
