together with all rights, interests, easements, hereditaments and applantenances thereunto belonging, the tents issues, and profits thereof ind revenues and income therefrom, all improvements and personal properts now or later attached thereto or reasonably necessary to the use thereof, including, but not limited to, ranges, refrigerators, clothes washers, clothes dryers, or carpeting parchased or financed in whole or in part with loan tunds, all water, water rights, and water stock pertaining thereto, and all payments at any time owing to B. frower by sirtue of any sile, lease, transfer, conveyance, or condemnation of any part thereof or interest therein all of which are herein called "the property".

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto the Government and its assigns forever in fee simple

BORROWIR for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, nuccessors and assigns WARRANTS THE TITLE to the property to the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or consequences specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGRIES as follows

- (1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured holder, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.
- (2) To pay to the Government such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home.

 Administration
- (3) If required by the Government, to make additional monthly payments of 1/12 of the estimated annual taxes, assessments, insurance premiums and other charges upon the mortgaged premises.
- (4) Whether or not the note is insured by the Government, the Government may at any time pay any other amounts required herein to be paid by Borrower and not paid by him when due, as well as any costs and expenses for the preservation, protection, or enforcement of this lien, as advances for the account of Borrower. All such advances shall hear interest at the rate home by the note which has the highest interest rate.
- (5) All advances by the Government as described in this instrument, with interest, shall be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government without demand at the place designated in the latest note and shall be secured hereby. No such advances by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of his covenant to pay. Any payment made by Borrower may be applied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any order the Government determines.
 - b. It use the I ame idenced by the note solely for purposes authorized by the Government.
- (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, judgments, encumbrances and assessments lamfully attaching to it assessed against the property and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipts evidencing such payments.
 - (8) To keep the property insured as required by and under insurance policies approved by, delivered to, and retained by the Government.
- (4) To maintain improvements in good repair and make repairs required by the Government, operate the property in a good and hosband-manlike manner, comply with such farm a necessary for ordinary of the security covered hereby, or without the written consent of the Government, cut, remove, or lease any timber, gravel, cil, was, coal, or other minerals except as may be necessary for ordinary ill-mestic purposes.
 - (10) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property.
- 11) To pay or reimburse the Government in expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to the protection of the lien and priority hereof and to the enforcement of to the compliance with the provisions hereof and of the note and any supplementary agreement (whether before or after default), including but not limited to a six of evidence of title to any survey of the property, costs of recording this and other instruments, attempts fees, trustees' fees, court costs, and expenses of advertising, selling, and conveying the property.
- (12) Neither the property nor any purtion thereof is interest therein shall be leased, assigned, sold, transferred, or encumbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as nortwaged hereunder, including but not limited to the power to grant consents, partial releases, subordinations, and satisfaction, and no insufe it like shall have any right of a nortenest in the time for any renefits here if.
- .13) At all reasonable runes the 19 sermment and its agents massinspect the property to ascertain whether the covenants and agreements contained berein or in any supplementary agreement are read performed.
- (14) The Government may extend and defer the majurity of and renew and rear-rive the debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, release from Lability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release portions of the property from and subordinate the lien hereof, and waive any other rights hereunder, without affecting the lien or priority hereof or the liability to the Government of Birrower in any other party for payment of the rivte or indebtedness secured hereby except as specified by the Government in writing.
- (15) If at any time it shall appear to the Gallerment that Born Aerita, be able to brain a loan from a production credit association, a Federal land bank, or other responsible cooperative or private credit source, at reasonable rates and terms for loans for similar purposes and periods of time. Borrower will, upon the Government's request apply for and a cooperative lending agency in connection, with such loan.
- (16) Default hereunder shall constitute default under any other real estate, or under any personal property or other, security instrument held or insured by the Government and executed or assumed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall constitute default hereunder.
- (17) SHOULD DEFAULT occur in the performance or discharge of any obligation secured by this instrument, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower die or be declared an incompetent, a bankrupt, or an insolvent, or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government at its option, with or without notice, may had declare the entire amount unpaid on der the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured immediately due and payable, the for the account of Borrower incur and pay reasonable expenses for repair or maintenance of and take possession of, operate or rent the property, (c) upon application by it and production of this instrument, without notice of hearing of said application, have a receiver applicated for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, (d) foreclose this instrument as provided herein or by law, and hereinger and all other rights and remedies provided herein or by present or future law.
- (18) The proceeds of foreclisure sale shall be applied in the following order to the payment of: (a) costs and expenses incident to enforcing or complying with the provisions hereof, (b) any prior liens required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (c) the debt evidenced by the note and all indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, do inferior liens of record required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (e) at the Government's option, any other indebtedness of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, and (f) any balance to Borrower. At foreclosure or other sale if all or any part of the property, the Government and its agents may bid and purchase as a stranger and may pay the Government's share of the purchase price by crediting such an ount on any debts of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, in the order prescribed above.
- (19) Burrower recognizes that, pursuant to Federal law, the opposition of the property, (b) prohibiting maintenance of an action for a deficiency judgment or limiting the amount thereof or the time within which such action may be brought, (c) prescribing any other statute of limitations, (d) allowing any right of redemption or possession following any foreclosure sale, or (e) limiting the conditions which the Government may by regulation in pose, including the interest rate it may barge, as a condition of approxing a transfer of the property to a new Borrower. Borrower expressly waives the benefit of any such State law.
- (20) If any part of the loan for which this instrument is given shall be used to finance the purchase, construction or repair of property to be used as an owner-occupied dwelling therein called "the dwelling"; and if Borrower intends to sell or rent the dwelling and has obtained the Government's consent to do so (a) neither Borrower nor anyone authorized to act for him, will, after receipt of a bona fide offer, refuse to negotiate for the sale or rental of the dwelling or will itherwise make unavailable or deny the dwelling to anyone because of race, color, religion or national origin, and (b) Borrower recognizes as illegal and hereby disclaims, and will not comply with or attempt to enforce any restrictive covenants on dwelling relating to race, color, religion, or national origin.
- (21) This instrument shall be subject to the present regulations of the Farmers Home Administration, and to its future regulations not inconsist nt with the express provisions hereof.
- (22) Notices given hereunder shall be sent by certified mail, unless otherwise required by law, addressed, unless and until some other address is designated in a notice so given, in the case of the Government to Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, at Columbia, South Carolina 29201, and in the case of Borrower to him at his post office address stated above.
- (23) If any provision of this instrument or application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity will not affect other provisions or applications of the instrument which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to that end the provisions hereof are declared to be severable.
