## THE LOMAS AND NETTLETON COMPANY, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, near the City of Greer and west therefrom, lying on the Southwest side of Golf Street being designated as Lot 2 on a plat of Vernon E. Fox, said plat being recorded in Plat Book "V", at page 176 in the RMC Office for Greenville County, and being further shown as Lot 2 on a plat of the property of Clyde W. Waddell and Mary H.
