If the total of the payments made by the Mortgagor under (b) of paragraph 2 preceding shall exceed the amount of payments actually made by the Mortgagee for taxes or assessments or insurance premiums, as the case may be, such excess, at the option of the Mortgagoe, shall be credited on subsequent payments to be made by the Mortgagor, or refunded to the Mortgagor.
