hereby, or if the property is otherwise acquired after default, the Mortgagee as trustee shall apply, at the time of the commencement of such proceedings, or at the time the property is otherwise acquired, the amount then remaining to credit of Mortgagor under (a) of paragraph 2 preceding, as a credit on the interest accrued and unpaid and the balance to the principal then remaining unpaid on the note secured hereby.

- 4. The lien of this instrument shall remain in full force and effect during any postponement or extension of the time of payment of the indebtedness or any part thereof secured hereby.
- 5. He will pay all taxes, assessments, water rates, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines, or impositions, for which provision has not been made hereinbefore, and in default thereof the Mortgagee may pay the same; and will promptly deliver the official receipts therefor to the Mortgagee. If the Mortgager fails to make any payments provided for in this section or any other payments for taxes, assessments, or the like, the Mortgagee may pay the same, and all sums so paid shall bear interest at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness from the date of such advance and shall be secured by this mortgage.
- 6. Upon the request of the Mortgagee the Mortgagor shall execute and deliver a supplemental note or notes for the sum or sums advanced by the Mortgagee for the alteration, modernization, improvement, maintenance or repair of said premises, for taxes or assessments against the same and for any other purpose authorized hereunder. Said note or notes shall be secured hereby on a parity with and as fully as if the advance evidenced thereby were included in the note first described above. Said supplemental note or notes shall bear interest at the rate provided for in the principal indebtedness and shall be payable in approximately equal monthly payments for such period as may be agreed upon by the creditor and debtor. Failing to agree on the maturity, the whole of the sum or sums so advanced shall be due and payable thirty (39) days after demand by the creditor. In no event shall the maturity extend beyond the ultimate maturity of the note first described above.
- 7. He will keep the premises in as good order and condition as they are now, reasonable wear and tear excepted, and will not commit or permit any waste thereof.
- 8. He will continuously maintain hazard insurance of such type or types and amounts as Mortgagee may from time to time require, on the improvements now or hereafter on sail premises, and except when I syment for all such premiums has therefore been made under (a) of paragraph 2 hereof, he will pay promptly when due any premiums therefor. All insurance shall be carried in companies approved by the Mortgagee and the policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee. In event of loss Mortgager will give immediate notice by mail to the Mortgagee, who may make proof of loss if not made promptly by Mortgager, and each insurance company concerned is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for such loss directly to the Mortgagee instead of to the Mortgager and Mortgagee jointly, and the insurance; records, or any part thereof, may be applied by the Mortgagee at its option either to the reduction of the indebtedness hereby secured or to the restoration or repair of the property damaged. In event of forcelosure of this mortgage, or other transfer of title to the mortgaged property in extinguishment of the indebtedness secured hereby, all right, title and interest of the Mortgagor in and to any insurance policies then in force shall pass to the purchaser or grantee.
- 9. He hereby assigns all the rents, issues, and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and should legal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, then the Mortgagee shall have the right to have a receiver appointed of the rents, issues, and profits, who, after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceedings and the execution of his trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, issues, and profits, toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.

It is agreed that the Mortgager shall held and erjoy the premises above conveyed until there is a default under this mortgage or in the note occured hereby. If the Mortgager shall fully perform all the terms, conditions, and covenants of this mortgage, and of the note occured hereby, then this mortgage shall be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. If there is a default in any of the terms, conditions, or covenants of this mortgage, or of the note occured hereby, then, at the option of the Mortgager, all sums then owing by the Mortgager to the Mortgages shall become immediately due and physide and this mortgage may be forcedesed. The Mortgager valves the benefit of any appraisement laws of the State of South Cardina. Should the Mortgage become a party to any suit involving this mortgage or the title to the premises described hardn (excluding legal precedings instituted for forcedesure or for the collection of the debt occured hereby all costs and expenses a wonable attorney's fee, shall be secured hereby and shall income due and payable thirty (30) days after demand. Should any legal proceedings be instituted for the force of this mortgage, or should the debt occured hereby or any part thereof be placed in the hands of an attorney at the forcellication by sait or otherwise, all costs and expenses, including continuation of abstract and a recovered and collected hereunder.

If the indebtedness secured hereby be guaranteed or insured at his Title 28, United St. 68 Code, such Title and Regulations issued thereunder and in effect on the date hereof shall govern the rights, duties and liabilities of the parties hereto, and any providers of this or other instruments executed in connection with said indebtedness which are inconsistent with said Title or Regulations are lareby amended to conform thereto.

The covenants herein contained shall bind, and the Lenefits and advantages shall inure to, the respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns of the parties hereto. Whenever used, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, the use of any gen ler shall be applicable to all ger best, and the term "Mortgagee" shall include any payce of the indebtedness hereby secured or any transferred thereof whether by operation of law or otherwise.
