CONTENTION ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforested debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagor at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagor and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and hardere the walling and debters of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, burgained, sold and released, and by these presents during the formal will and release unto the Mortgagor its successors and assigns.

All that certain piece,

parcel, or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Paris Mountain Township, at the intersection of North Parker Road and Old Poorhouse Road, being known as a part of Tract No. 80 of the Parker Land Company, and having, according to a plat prepared for D. U. Mauldin by C. C. Jones, Engineer, dated March 15, 1958, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a nail and cap in the center of the Old Poorhouse Road where the same intersects with the center of North Parker Road, and running thence with the center of the Old Poorhouse Road, N. 46-53 E. 372 feet to a nail and cap; thence leaving said road and running N. 46-17 W. 269.6 feet to a nail and cap in the center of North Parker Road; thence with the center of North Parker Road, the following courses and distances: S. 10-12 E. 95.5 feet, S. 3-29 E. 100 feet, S. 15-40 W. 100 feet, and S. 23-15 W. 165 feet to the point of beginning.



Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appartenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rests, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting futures now or hereafter attached connected, or fitted thereto in any maziner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such futures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully second of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all hers and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all per; as whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows

- the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortcage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgager by the Mortgager so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All some so advanced or all hear increase at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
- (2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or bereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such mounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals there is shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due, and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgage I premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the bilance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.
