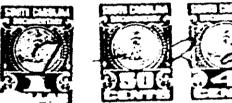

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums and other obligations for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, the Maximum Outstanding at any given time not to exceed said amount stated above, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns

ALL that certain piece, purcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, fring and being in the State of South Carolina, County of GREENVILLE . to wit. All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 3.1 acres, more or less, in County and State aforesaid, on the West side of the Hendersonwille Road (S.C. Highway 117) North of the Community of Tigerville, and having according to a plat and survey entitled "Drawn for Ralph M. Sloan" dated June 11, 1973, prepared by Carolina Engine -ering and Surveying Company, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appartenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, essues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or bereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be companiered a grant of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe, its hours, successors and assums, foreset

The Mortgagor coverants that at is lawfully secred of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, comes or encumber the same, and that the greenises are free and clear of all hers and encumbrances except as herein specifically stated otherwise as follows:

This is a second Mortgage, second only to the one held by F.H.A.

The Mostgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagor forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever fawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgapor further coverants and agrees as follows:

- the That this mostgage shall secure the Mostgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mostgagee, for the payment of taxes, incurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the coverants herein. This mortgage diall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagee to the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the cerginal amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
- 42) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaped property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgaper against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgaper, an an amount not less than the mortgape dold, or an such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereod shall be held by the Mortgagee, and that it does hereby assign to the guivable clauses in face, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due, and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgagee debt, whether due or not.
- (3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction bean, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upon said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the expenses for such repairs of the completion of such construction to the mortexecc debt.
- (4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other impositions against the meetigaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgaged premises
- (5) That it hereby assigns all rents, issues and profits of the mortgaged premises from and after any default hereunder, and agrees that, should logal proceedings be instituted pursuant to this instrument, any judge having jurisdiction may, at Chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the mortgaged premises and collect the rents, issues and profits, including a reasonable rental to be fixed by the Court in the event said premises are occupied by the mortgagor and after deducting all charges and expenses attending such proceeding and the execution of its trust as receiver, shall apply the residue of the rents, the issues and profits toward the payment of the debt secured hereby.

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
