Together with all and singular rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or apper-taining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; at being the intention of the parties hereto that all fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, he considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its beirs, successors and assigns, forever-

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided berein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

That this mortenee shall scenre the Mortexee TOT SUCH TWENCE ST DEG CERTAILET. gee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgages for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgages so long as the total indebtness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgages unless otherwise provided to writing.
