NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aferesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargainard, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, being and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, situate, lying and being on the western side of Pimlico Road, in the City of Greenville, being known and designated as the major portion of Lot No. 105 on a plat of SECTION A of GOWER ESTATES, made by Dalton & Neves, dated January 1960, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ, pages 146 and 147, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Pimlico Road(said point being located N. 22-14 E., 10 feet from the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 104 and 105) and running thence along a new line through Lot No. 105, S. 67-46 W., 154 feet to a point in the center of a branch; thence with the center of said branch the traverse line being N. 25-06 W., 90.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 105 and 106; thence with the common line of said lots, N. 67-46 E., 159 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Pimlico Road; thence with the western side of Pimlico Road, S. 22-14 E., 90 feet to a point, 10 feet North of the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 104 and 105, the point of BEGINNING.
