All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, bying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville. near Ware Place, on the eastern side of Old Hundred Road, containing 4.77 acres, more or less, shown on a survey entitled "A Subdivision of Property of Helen D. Babb Whitney" prepared by J. Don Lee, dated April 1, 1975" recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 5K at Page 111, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
