Any amounts disbursed by Lender pursuant to this paracraph 7, with interest there in, shall become additional indebtedness of Borrower secured by this Mortgage. Unless Borrower and Lender agree to other terms of payment, such amounts shall be payable upon notice from Lender to Borrower requesting payment thereof, and shall bear interest from the date of disbursement at the rate payable from time to time on outstanding principal under the Note unless payment of interest at such rate would be outrary to applicable law, in which event such amounts shall bear interest at the highest rate permissible under applicable law. Nothing outstanding in this paragraph 7 shall require Lender to incur any expense or take any action hereunder.

- 8. Inspections. Lender may make or cause to be made reasonable entries upon and inspections of the Property, provided that Lender shall give Borrower notice prior to any such inspection specifying reasonable cause therefor related to Lender's interest in the Property.
- 9. Condemnation. The proceeds of any award or claim for damages, direct or consequential, in connection with any condemnation or other taking of the Property, or part thereof, or for obveyance in lieu of condemnation, are hereby assigned and shall be paid to Lender.

In the event of a total taking of the Property, the proceeds shall be applied to the sums secured by this Margage, with the excess, if any, paid to Borrower. In the event of a partial taking of the Property, unless Borrower and Lender otherwise agree in writing, there shall be applied to the sums secured by this Morgage such proportion of the proceeds as is equal to that proportion which the amount of the sums secured by this Morgage immediately prior to the date of taking lears to the fair market value of the Property immediately prior to the date of taking, with the balance of the proceeds paid to Borrower.

If the Property is abandoned by Borrower, or if, after notice by Lender to Borrower that the condemotr offers to make an award or settle a claim for damages, Borrower fails to respond to Lender within 30 days after the date such notice is mailed, Lender is authorized to collect and apply the proceeds, at Lender's option, either to restoration or repair of the Property or to the sums secured by this Mertgage.

Unless Lender and Dorrower otherwise agree in writing, any such application of proceeds to principal shall not extend or postpone the due date of the monthly installments referred to in paragraphs 1 and 2 horeoff or change the amount of such installments.

- 10. Borrower Nor Released. Extension of the time for payment or medification of amortization of the sums secured by this Mertgage granted by Lender to any successor in interest of B traver shall not operate to release, in any manner, the liability of the original Borrower and Borrower's successors in interest. Lender shall not be required to commence proceedings against such successor or refuse to extend time for payment or otherwise modify amortization of the sums secured by this Mertgage by reason of any demand made by the original Borrower and Borrower's success is in interest.
- 11. For Bearance By Lender Not a Waiver. - 12. REMEDIES CUMULATIVE. All remedies provided in this Morigage are distinct and cumulative to any other right or remedy under this Morigage or afforded by law or equity, and may be exercised to neutrently, independently or successively.
- 13. Successors and Assions Bound; Joint and Several Liability; Captions. The covenants and agreements herein contained shall bind, and the rights hereunder shall inute to, the respective success is and assigns of Lender and B frower, subject to the proxisions of paragraph 17 hereof. All covenants and agreements of B frower shall be joint and several. The captions and headings of the paragraphs of this Mortgage are for convenience only and are not to be used to interpret or define the provisions hereof.
- 14. Notice. Except for any notice required under applicable law to be given in another manner, (a) any notice to Bottower provided for in this Mortgage shall be given by mailing such notice by certified mail addressed to Bottower at the Property address or at such other address as Bottower may designate by notice to Lender as provided herein, and (b) any notice to Lender shall be given by certified mail, return receipt requested, to Lender's address stated herein or to such other address as Lender may designate by notice to Bottower as provided herein. Any notice provided for in this Mortgage shall be deemed to have been given to Bottower or Lender when given in the manner designated herein.
- 15. Uniform Mortgage; Governing Law: Severalitity. This form of merigage combines uniform covenants for national use and non-uniform covenants with limited variations by jurisdiction to constitute a uniform security instrument covering real property. This Merigage shall be governed by the law of the jurisdiction in which the Property is located. - 16. Borrower's Corv. Borrower shall be furnished a conformed copy of the Note and of this Mortgage at the time of execution or after recordation hereof.
- 17. Transfer of the Property; Assumption. If all or any part of the Property or an interest therein is sold or transferred by Borrower without Lender's prior written consent, excluding [a], the creation of a lien or encumbrance subordinate to this Mortgage, (b) the creation of a purchase money security interest for household appliances, [c] a transfer by devise, descent or by operation of law upon the death of a joint tenant or (d) the grant of any leasehold interest of three years or less not containing an option to purchase, Lender may, at Lender's option, declare all the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable. Lender shall have waived such option to accelerate if, prior to the sale or transfer, Lender and the person to whom the Property is to be sold or transferred reach agreement in writing that the credit of such person is satisfactory to Lender and that the interest payable on the sums secured by this Mortgage shall be at such rate as Lender shall request. The notice shall further inform Borrower of the right to reinstate after acceleration and the right to assert in the preclosure proceeding the non-existence of a default or any other defense of Borrower to acceleration and foreclosure. If the breach is not cured on or before the date specified in the notice, Lender it Lender's option may declare all of the sums secured by this Mortgage to be immediately due and payable without further demand and may foreclose this Mortgage by judicial proceeding. Lender shall be entitled to collect in such proceeding all expenses of free closure, including, but not limited to reason ble atterney's fees, and costs of decomentary evidence, abstracts and title reports, all of which shall be additional sums secured by this Mortgage.
