TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, WE the said C. Adger and Donna King Roberts hereinafter called Mortgagor, in and by OUR certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted, firmly held and bound unto THE CITIZENS AND SOUTHERN NATIONAL BANK OF SOUTH CAROLINA, hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just principal sum of Eleven thousand six hundred nine & 68/100 Dollars (\$11,609.68), with interest thereon payable in advance from date hereof at the rate of 11.86 % per annum; the principal of said note together with interest being due and payable in (96)

Monthly installments as follows: Beginning on THE LAST DAY OF JANUARY, 19 76, and on the same day of each Monthly period thereafter, the sum of One hundred eighty-nine & 23/100 Dollars (\$189.23) and the balance of said principal sum due and payable on the day of 19

The aforesaid payments are to be applied first to interest at the rate stipulated above and the balance on account of unpaid principal. Provided, that upon the sale, assignment, transfer or assumption of this mortgage to or by a third party without the written consent of the Bank, the entire unpaid balance of the note secured by this mortgage, with accrued interest, shall become due and payable in full or may, at the Bank's option, be continued on such terms, conditions, and rates of interest as may be acceptable to the Bank.

Said note provides that past due principal and/or interest shall bear interest at the rate of % per annum, or if left blank, at the maximum legal rate in South Carolina, as reference being had to said note will more fully appear; default in any payment of either principal or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the mortgagee or holder hereof. Forbearance to exercise this right with respect to any failure or breach of the maker shall not constitute a waiver of the right as to any subsequent failure or breach. Both principal and interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America, at

the office of the Mortgagee in GREENVILLE, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder hereof may from time to time designate in writing.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that the said Mortgagor in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said Note; and also in consideration of the further sum of THREE DOLLARS, to the said Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land on the western side of the Augusta Road (U.S. Highway 25 South) in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown and designated as 0.88 acres on a plat entitled "Property of William H. Rice", dated April 24, 1970, by Jones Engineering Service, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the western side of Augusta Road, at the joint front corner of property now or formerly belonging to "Martin" and running thence with said "Martin" line S. 77-17 W., 103.4 feet to a point on the line of property now or formerly belonging to "Vance"; thence with said "Vance" line S. 6-30 W., 306.5 feet to a point; thence S. 77-12 E., 122.5 feet to a point on the western side of the Augusta Road; thence with the western side of the Augusta Road N. 5-16 E., 180 feet to a point; thence continuing with the western edge of the Augusta Road N. 0-11 W., 175.3 feet to the point of beginning. This conveyence is subject to restrictive covenants of record, setback lines, road or passageways, easements and rights of way, if any, affecting the above described property. This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed dated May 8, 1972, and recorded in Deed Book 943, at page 167 in the RMC Office for Greenville County.



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
