(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto WOODRUFF FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of ELEVEN HUNDRED and no/100 DOLLARS (\$ 1,100.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate as specified in said note, said

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about two miles North of Greer, and being known and designated as Lot No. Six (6) of the W. Dennis Smith property as shown on plat prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, dated July 29, 1952, and which plat has been recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County in Plat Book T, page 452. This being the same property which was conveyed to Melvin N. Alexander and Helen C. Alexander by W. Dennis Smith by deed recorded in said office in Deed Book 479, page 414.
