That certain lot, parcel or tract of land, with all improvements now constructed thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. County of Greenville, in the Highland Township, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake in the Gowansville Road on line of property of W. A. and Henry Briggs; thence along the center of said road N. 1-51 W. 500 feet to an angle in the road; thence N. 5-06 W. 600 feet to an angle; thence N. 18-47 W. 194 feet to a point in the road on a bridge; thence leaving the road and running along the Wooten property S. 86-14 W. 1400 feet to an iron pin; thence along property of R. Fisher S. 17-21 W. 479 feet to a stone at the head of a ditch; thence down a ditch S. 37-02 W. 238 feet to an iron pin; there continuing with a ditch crossing a branch S. 3-48 W. 631.5 feet to an iron pin on line of W.
