(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

---Twenty Thousand Three Hundred and 00/100-----

DOLLARS (\$20,300.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate provided for in said note, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, except that the final payment of principal and interest shall be due on

April 1, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Town of Simpsonville, and being shown and designated as Lot no. 619 on plat of Westwood, Section 6, Sheet 1, which plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4X at page 100, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Yellow Wood Drive, joint front corner of Lots 618 and 619 and running thence along the joint line of Lots 618 and 619, S. 15-00 W., 140 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 77-17 E., 25 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-28 E., 77.78 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 619 and 620; thence turning and running along said joint line of Lots 619 and 620 N. 8-00 E., 140 feet to an iron pin in the southern side of Yellow Wood Drive; thence along the southern side of said Yellow Wood Drive, S. 89-46 W., 22 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along said Yellow Wood Drive N. 86-00 W., 50 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing N. 77-42 W., 14 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.

Being the same property conveyed to mortgagors by deed of Builders and Developers, Inc., dated March 8, 1976.
