All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South
Carolina, near the City of Greenville, being situated in the northern corner of the
intersection of Penarit Street (formerly Little Street) and Lilac Street and being
known and designated as lot ~~number 12~~ of the property of William H. Timmons, Jr.,
as shown by plat recorded in Plat Book "XV" page 9, Greenville County R. M. C. Office
