TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: ROBERT CARNES and EDNA CARNES

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the sum of Twenty-five Thousand Six Hundred and no/100ths -----DOLLARS

(\$ 25,600.00), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's note of even date, bearing interest as stated in said note, and payable as therein stated or as modified by mutual agreement, in writing, the final maturity of which is 30 years after the date hereof, unless extended by mutual consent, the terms of said note and any agreement modifying it are incorporated herein by reference; and

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Town of Mauldin, on the northern side of Banner Street, being known and designated as Lot No. 95 on a MAP OF GLENDALE, PROPERTY OF WILLIAM R. TIMMONS, JR., made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, dated May, 1953, revised May, 1959, recorded in the RMC Office for said county and state in Plat Book QQ, pages 76 and 77, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the northern side of Banner Street, at the joint front corners of Lots Nos. 94 and 95 and running thence with the northern side of said street, S. 77-53 E., 138.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the common line of Lots Nos. 95 and 96, N. 12-07 E., 194.7 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear lines of Lots Nos. 91 and 92, N. 84-59 W., 78.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 93, S. 49-46 W., 100 feet to an iron pin; thence along the common line of Lots Nos. 94 and 95, S. 12-07 W., 105.8 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
