WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW. KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagoe to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, as is more fully shown on a plat of property of Ward S. Stone, prepared October 7, 1955 by Piedmont Engineering Service and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book WW, at Page 454, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of Evelyn Avenue and an unnamed street and running thence along the southern side of the unnamed street, N. 75-17 E. 18.2 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 22-30 E. 317.55 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the same course 86.2 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 86-49 W. 183 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Evelyn Avenue; running thence along the eastern side of Evelyn Avenue, N. 1-37 E. 76.7 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the same course along the eastern side of said Evelyn Avenue 301.45 feet to the point of beginning.
