NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots No. 72 and 73 of River Downs, and, according to a plat prepared by Piedmont Engineers and Architects, Dated April 7, 1977, entitled "Property of K. Don Chambers and Wanda Marie Chambers", recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat 6 at page 97, having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the western side of Hammett Road at the joint corner of Lot No. 72 and property of Hoffman and running thence with Hammett Road, S. 44-21 E., 100.0 feet to an iron pin; thence still with Hammett Road, S. 41-36 E., 72.0 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Hammett Road and a proposed road; thence with said proposed road, S. 4-54 W., 34.42 feet to an iron pin on proposed road; thence with said proposed road, S. 51-24 W., 230 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner with property of Blanche Eugenia Hudson and Lot No. 73; thence with the Hudson property line, N. 41-30 W., 199.45 feet to an iron pin on line of property of Hoffman; thence with the Hoffman line, N. 52-02 E., 250.0 feet to an iron pin on the western side of Hammett Road, being the point of beginning.
