with interest thereon from date at the rate of \_\_\_\_\_ per centum per annum, to be paid

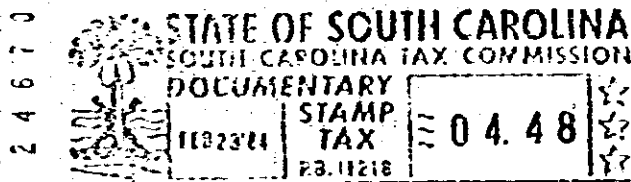
WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or  
for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and  
of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his  
account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly  
paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has grant-  
ed, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and as-  
signs:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and  
being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in the Town of Fountain Inn, on  
the eastern side of Craig Street, and containing one-half acre, more  
or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Craig Street, which iron pin is situate  
175.56 feet N. 3-45 E. from the intersection of Craig Street and Fowler  
Street, and running thence S. 75 E. 288.42 feet; thence S. 1-62 W. along  
the line of lot of Jewell E. Williams, 79.2 feet; thence N. 75 W. along  
the lines of lots belonging to W. A. Weathers and Bentley, 270.6 feet to  
an iron pin on the eastern side of Craig Street; thence N. 3-45 E. along  
the eastern side of Craig Street 79.2 feet to the point of beginning.

This being the same property as conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of  
Blanch T. Eddleman Burts and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-  
ville County in Deed Book 1206, Page 832, on Feb. 24, 1984.

fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such  
fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute that it has good right  
and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances  
except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
