(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further :

ereafter, at the option of the ses pursuant to the covenants Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessm its that may be made hereafter herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, reauvaire 22 to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.

(2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals O thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the O Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgagee debt, whether due or not.

(3) That it will keep all improvements now existing or hereafter erected in good repair, and, in the case of a construction loan, that it will continue construction until completion without interruption, and should it fail to do so, the Mortgagee may, at its option, enter upor said premises, make whatever repairs are necessary, including the completion of any construction work underway, and charge the - expenses for such repairs or the completion of such construction to the mortgagee debt.

(4) That it will pay, when due, all taxes, public assessments, and other governmental or municipal charges, fines or other imposition - against the mortgaged premises. That it will comply with all governmental and municipal laws and regulations affecting the mortgage premises.
