hereinafter called "Borrower," and (2) jointly indebted to the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, herein called "the Government," as evidenced by one or more certain promissory note(s) or assumption agreement(s), herein called "note" (if more than one note as described below the word "note" as used herein shall be construed as referring to each note singly or all notes collectively, as the context may require), said note being executed by Borrower, being payable to the order of the Government in installments as specified therein, authorizing acceleration of the entire indebtedness at the option of the Government upon any default by Borrower, and being further described as follows:

The mortgagor and mortgagee agree that any ranges, refrigerators, or carpeting purchased or financed in whole or in part, with loan funds will be considered and construed as a part of the property covered by the mortgage.
