THESE ARTICLES OF AGREEMENT, Entered into this 30th day of June , 19 etween Lieut., Col. R.E. Grinstead , Quartermaster Corps, U. S. Army nd in behalf of the United States of America (hereinafter designated as lessee), of the first nd S.J. Heatherly Spartanburg , in the County of Spartanburg , and S. Spartanburg , in the County of Spartanburg , and S. South Carolina (hereinafter designated as lessor), of the second part, Wirm That the said parties do hereby mutually covenant and agree to and with each other as follows: 1. That the said lessor shall, and by these presents does hereby lease, demise, and let to the lessed ollowing-described premises, to have and to hold the same with their appurtenances, unto the lessee, for the permission of the second part, with July 1st, 1918 , 19 , and ending with June 30th, 1919 , and the per month and under the conditions named below, viz:	y, for part, State NESS: e the r the t the
All that certain tract and parcel of land situated in Spartanburg Township Spartanburg County, South Carolina, containing approximately four (4) acres, are bounded on the South by lands of J.F. Cleveland, on the East by lands of J.F. Cleveland, and on the West by lands of J.F. Cleveland, at a rental of FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00 month for a term beginning on the 1st day of July, 1918 and ending on the 30th of June, 1919. The lessee shall have the right to cut, remove and destroy any wood thereon, by paying to the owner of the land Fifty cents (\$.50) per cord or stump for all live wood so cut, removed and destroyed. The lessee shall have the further right to work, grade, ditch or drain any part of the tract, and erect of struct buildings, target pits, firing trenches etc., as may be necessary for the interest of the Government. 2. That the said lessor will warrant and defend to the lessee, its officers and agents, the quiet and peaceable ossession and occupancy of the aforesaid premises, and in case of any disturbance, by suit or otherwise, fill defend the same free of charge to the Government in or before the proper State or United States courts.

- 3. That Merchal lessershalk copyrhopicoises in good repair to the sanstration of the New remnent rofficer are the lessee shall be under improvements fixed to or erected or placed in or upon the said premises by the lessee shall be and remain the exclusive property of the lessee, provided, however, that the same, unless old or otherwise disposed of, shall be removed by the lessee within ninety days after the said premises re vacated under this lease.
- 5. That it is expressly agreed and understood that this lease shall be noneffective until an appropriation dequate to its fulfillment is granted by Congress and is available, except in so far as is necessary to provide or the necessities of the service as authorized by section 3732 of the Revised Statutes of the United States. In order to provide for the necessities of the service as authorized by said section, it is agreed that he premises specified herein, so far as authorized by said section, shall be occupied by the lessee as contemplated by this lease, and that payment of the rental shall be made as soon as is practicable after funds re appropriated and are available.
- 6. That no Member of or Delegate to Congress, or Resident Commissioner, nor any person belonging to or mployed in the military service of the United States, is, or shall be admitted to any share or part of this ontract, or to any benefit which may arise herefrom, but, under the provisions of section 116 of the act of longress approved March 4, 1909 (35 Stat. L., 1109), this stipulation, so far as it relates to Members of or Delegates to Congress, or Resident Commissioners, shall not extend, or be construed to extend, to any contract nade with an incorporated company for its general benefit.
- 7. That the lessor hereby stipulates that no part of the money received as rental will be given to the ccupant of the above-described premises, or to the person for whose benefit or use they were hired, or to nyone for him, nor will any rebate be given on said rental for the benefit of any such person.
- 9. That, at the option of the lessee, this lease, with all its covenants and agreements, may be renewed early as often as the needs of the public service may require, so as to give the lessee continuous possession f the premises, not extending, however, beyond June 30, 19 , but no renewal shall be made to include nore than one fiscal year.
- 10. In case of renewal, as provided in Article 9, the rent will be at the rate of FORTY DOLLARS (\$40.00) per month, no renewal lease being made for less than one Fiscal year, owing to the lessor's losing the use of this farm for regular corn crop.
