1. In accordance with the order of the Secretary of War, under date of November 26, 1918, (copy of which is hereto attached) YOU ARE HEREBY DIRECTED to

ABANDON THE FOLLOWING PROJECTS AT
CAMP WADSWORTH, SOUTH CAROLINA.

2515-4, Laundry and Power Plant
2515-6, Fences at Auxiliary Remount Depot
2515-20, Alteration of prison ward.
2515-21, Delousing Plant, 32' x 84', dwg. 632-551.

Orders for Delousing equipment will not be abandoned as the equipment will be installed in some other building already erected.

2515-24, Coffee Roasting and Grinding Plant.

It is the Policy of the War Department to abandon all tent camps as soon as possible. No further improvements will be made at tent camps, other than those necessary for the health and care of the garrisons now quartered thereat or to be sent there for demobilization.

Work on this project must be stopped immediately as otherwise any further expenditures made in furthering the construction or completion, other than those necessary to prevent damage to Government property or to prevent other losses to the Government, would be wasteful and are prohibited.


