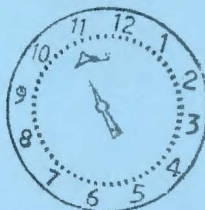
The leases for the camp sites and in some instances for the base hospitals and the auxiliary remount depots for these camps have been executed by this office. The contracts for water supply and electric service to these camps have also been executed by this office.

2. Inasmuch as the current fiscal year terminates on June 30, and it will soon become necessary to renew these leases and contracts, this office desires to know when and where it may secure information as to which leases and contracts are to be renewed.

3. Some of these camps will undoubtedly be discontinued, and in such cases it would not of course, be necessary to renew all of the leases or to hold all of the land under lease where one or two leases cover the entire camp.

4. Under instructions from the Adjutant Generals' Office dated Dec. 5, 1917, the leases for target and rifle ranges at these camps have been prepared and executed at the camps, and in some cases the leases for the base hospitals, remount depots, and camps proper, have been prepared there. It is presumed that any leases prepared at the camps for lands which the Government desires to retain beyond the current fiscal year will be renewed at the camps.

5. If your office can give any advance information relative to the renewal of leases and contracts for the camps named above, it is


