KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Whereas the undersigned is  
 ( the owner of )

 as follows: all that tract of land in the limits of Camp  
Wadsworth bounded by lands of Cleveland, Hadden  
Bonner, Carlisle and others, as shown on map of  
Camp Wadsworth,  
 comprising 630.90 acres more or less; and Whereas the United States of  
America did take possession of said tract of land under lease dated July 4-1917  
 and use and occupy the same as part of Camp Wadsworth;  
 and did by reason of the taking of possession or through the use thereof,  
 damage the undersigned in her right of possession thereof or in the  
 use thereof;

NOW THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of One Dollar in hand  
 paid and other good and valuable considerations the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged, the undersigned for her self, her heirs, legal representa-  
 tives and assigns or successors does hereby release, acquit and forever dis-  
 charge the United States of America and its successors of and from any and all  
 claims and demands for damages to the undersigned and to the tract of land, or  
 the tenements, appurtenances and hereditaments thereunto appertaining, or the  
 improvements thereon, in any manner growing out of or relating to the taking  
 possession, or the use by the United States of America of said above described  
 tract of land.

And the undersigned for her self, her heirs, legal representatives  
 and assigns or successors, does hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless the  
United States of America and its successors of and from any and all claims and  
 demands or suits at law that may be brought thereon, arising out of or relating  
 to the claim or demand hereby released.
