the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.H. Rush, all that certain lot or parcel of land, situate in the City of Greenville and County and State aforesaid, being the same lot of land conveyed by Geo. Westmoreland to Mt. Zion Baptist Church by deed dated October 5, 1891, and recorded in Book XX, page 873, in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County, and found by survey made by W.D. Neves, D.S. by survey made on the 8th day of January, 1913 to have the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stake 3X on Hudson Street, thence with said Street S. 22-30 W. 77 feet to stake 3X of Hudson and Meadow Streets, thence with Meadow Street N. 56 W. 117 feet to P.C. 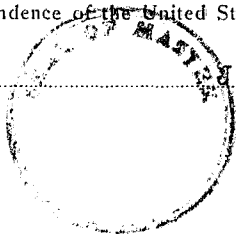
