the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W. Norwood, All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the County and

State aforesaid and Grove Township, containing fifty-seven and four tenths acres, more or less and bounded by lands of Jesse Morgan, Jerry McKenzie and V. R. Jenkins and being the same tract of land conveyed to W.A. Bishop by V. R. Jenkins by deed and recorded in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Book ZZZ page 387.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and each of them in and to the same; and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by these or any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned, unto the said J.W. Norwood, his

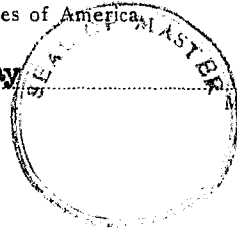
heirs and assigns forever.
