Cole, James R. Cole, Mollie Shockley, Eleanor Alexander, Sarah E. Cole, Elrenza G. Cole, Joseph L. Cole and John B. Cole.

demanding that the real estate described in the complaint be partitioned among the parties interested therein; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 17th, day of June 1911, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by J.W. Gray

NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, J.W. Gray Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

James B. Thompson, for and in consideration of Five thousand eight hundred and seventy-five dollars to me in hand paid by the said James B. Thompson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, all that tract of land situate in County and State aforesaid on Richland Creek, on the Rutherford Road about three miles from Greenville Courthouse, being a part of the tract of land conveyed by Wilhelmina Chaplin to Lewis G. Cole by deed dated November 3, 1873, and recorded in the office of R.M.C. G.C. in Book F.F., page 142, containing fifty-two and one-half (52-1/2) acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on bank of Richland Creek and running; thence S. 80 E. 11.50 E. to stake on bank of said Creek; thence N. 13-3/4 E. 31.95 to stake; thence N. 43.30 W. 9.73 to stake in Rutherford Road; thence with said Road as the line S. 56 W. 14.38 to stake in road; thence S. 8 E. 7.55 W. to stone; thence S. 48 W. 7.65 to stone; thence S. 37-1/4 E. 5.09 to stone; thence S. 15-3/4 W. 2.00 to stone; thence S. 22-1/2 E. 4.90 to stone; thence S. 6 W. 3.90 to beginning corner.

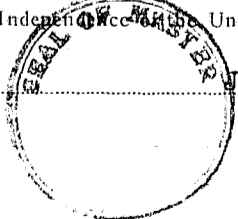
