I, J.W. Gray, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING: WHEREAS, Lou Thompson, et al

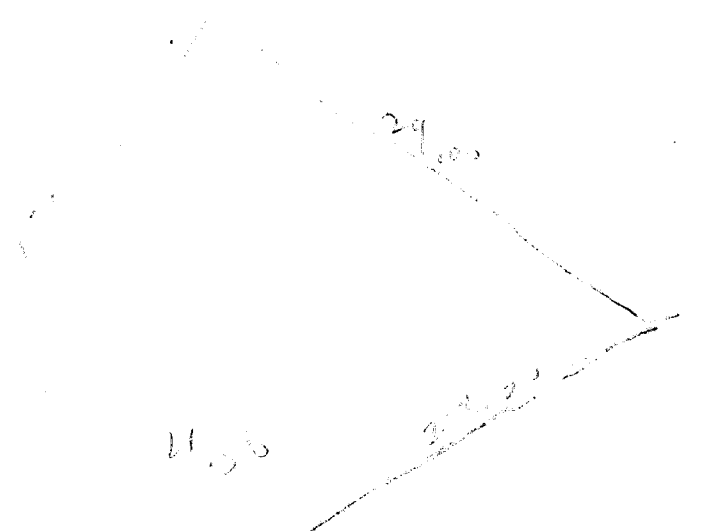
on or about the 17th, day of February in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and eleven exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Gabe Thompson, et al

demanding that the real estate described in the complaint be partitioned among the parties interested therein; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 25th, day of February 1911, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by J.W. Gray Master in and for the County aforesaid, to P.M. Thompson for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 3491)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know all men by these Presents, that I, J.W. Gray Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

P.M. Thompson all that certain tract of land situate in Paris Mountain Township County and State aforesaid, known as tract No. 7, on the plat of survey of the lands of the Estate of Gabriel-Thompson, deceased made by W.A. Hester, Surveyor on the 12th, day of November, 1910, containing forty-three and one-fourth (43-1/4) acres, more or less and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning on a stone at ford of Green Brier Creek and running up and with said Creek as the line 23.00 to willow; thence N. 50 W. 29.00 to W.O. stump on branch; thence S. 33-1/2 W. 17.00 to Pine XXNM3; thence S. 40-3/4 E. 21.50 to stone at ford of Creek, the beginning corner.

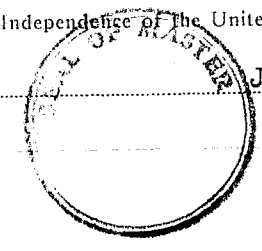
