Rowley, All that certain tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, bounded by lands of Ferguson, Thornberg, Southern, Benson and others, containing one hundred and eighty-seven acres, two roods and 5.42 perches, more or less, lying on waters of Saluda River, and being the land conveyed to Dr. E. F. S. Rowley by E. F. S. Rowley and others, by deed dated the 22nd, day of October, 1900, deed recorded in Book 666, at page 378.
