all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles south of Conestee Mills, having the following courses and distances according to survey made by W.J. 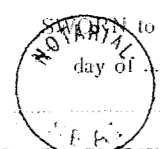
