 in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. T. Bright

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said J. T. Bright, all that piece, parcel and tract of land lying being and situate in State and County aforesaid, on the Pelham Road, and adjoining lands of J. A. Wood and others, and having the following metes and bounds, Beginning at a stone corner on the Pelham Road and running thence N. 79 degrees W. 22.37 chs. to a stone, thence S. 79-3/4 degrees E. 24.60 chs. to a stone; thence N. 84-3/4 degrees W. 12.50 chs. to a stone on the said Pelham Road; thence along with the said Pelham Road to the beginning corner, and containing thirty-one and two-tenths acres (31.2) more or less. This tract of land is known as tract No. 9 of the line on Hughes land.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. T. Bright and his heirs and assigns, forever.
