NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I B. E. Johnson
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and 20/100
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. P. Gibson

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
M. P. Gibson, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of
land situate lying and being in the County, and State
aforesaid, in or near the Town of Greer and having the
following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a
point on Congress Street at corner of lot No. 10 and run
with said lot 58.8 feet to corner of lot No. 12, thence
along the line of lot No. 12, 199.7 feet, thence 58.8 feet
to corner of lot No. 10, thence along the line of lot No
10 199.2 feet to the beginning corner, and being known
as lot No. 11 on a plat of lots recorded in plat Book
"A" at page 299. And being the same lot of land
conveyed to me by E. D. Greep by deed bearing date of
October 3rd 1916.
