NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I Olive A. Peace
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. D. Parrish and T. C. Ewers

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
M. D. Parrish and T. C. Ewers, all that certain lot of land
situate on the north side of West Earle Street, in the
First Ward of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville State
of South Carolina, Partition and designated as lot # 34 of
Section "C" as shown on Plot of Lands of the Stone Land
Company, recorded in the A. M. C. office for Greenville County,
Deed Book "A", page 337 to 345, and having the following
metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at stake on the
north side of West Earle Street and corner of lot # 32,
approximately 27 1/2 feet 10 1/2 inches east of Robinson Street
and running thence with line of said lot # 32, N. 1-41 E.
200 feet to a stake on a 16 foot alley, thence with said
alley S. 83-13 C. 54 feet 4 1/2 inches to stake, thence S.
1-41 W. 200 feet to stake on Earle Street; thence with
Earle Street N. 83-13 W. 54 feet 4 1/2 inches to the begin-
ning corner, being the same lot that day conveyed
to me by J. J. Westervelt.
