(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Joe H. Knight:— All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate and lying in the county and state aforesaid about three miles South-west of the town of Fountain Inn, containing 1 ty acres, more or less, bounded by lands of J. J. Andrews, Robt Rogers Estate, L. M. Wash and others, beginning at a post oak 3x and running thence 86 3/4 W 33.90 to a poplar, on branch, thence N. 17 1/2 W. 11.00 to Hickory, thence N 72 1/2 E. 32.58 to a P.O., thence S 88 19.73 to beginning corner, being the same tract of land conveyed to me by J.
