NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, W. H. Barkley and Bessie Barkley in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other Valuable Consideration DOLLARS, to, and in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. C. King

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. C. King, his heirs and assigns, All that parcel or tract of land situate on waters of Horse Creek, Duplin Township, in the County and State aforesaid, adjoining the William Sims land and others, containing one hundred and forty-five and one half acres, more or less, less eleven and one tenth acres conveyed by William Scott to James Campbell, by Deed dated the 22nd day of August 1884, recorded in Vol. 197 page 295, being the same land conveyed to me by J. W. Gray master by Deed dated the 8th day of August 1905 and recorded in Vol. 40 page 109.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W. C. King, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. C. King, his heirs and assigns, against ourselves and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
